"Fely" and her 9 husband were forced to buy and sell fish in the surrounding villages, and they were 10 still able to sustain their five (5) children; and 11 WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Castillo moved to Guam in 1987, and they now live 12 with their son, Ricardo A. Castillo, in the village of Yigo; and 13 WHEREAS, "Fely" and her husband became active members of the senior citizens community of Guam by frequenting the Yigo Senior Citizens Center, where 14 they learned to dance, sing and exercise for fun; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Castillo would often share stories with her family of the active life at the Yigo Senior Citizens Center and the many outings they enjoyed, such 17 as luncheons at local hotels; and 18 WHEREAS, "Fely" was an avid attendee of the Senior Center until she 19 20 recently experienced a fall that left her with a fractured hip. "Fely" spent some time in the Guam Memorial Hospital Skilled Nursing Unit, and she is now recuperating 21 22 comfortably at home, where nurses and friends from the Senior Center come to visit 23 her several times a week; and 24 WHEREAS, Mrs. Castillo enjoys mangos and bitter melon as her favorite fresh 25 produce to keep her healthy, and she also enjoys playing card games and bingo to

26 keep her busy; and

1 WHEREAS, "Fely" and her husband are blessed with their greatest treasure, 2 their family of sixteen (16) grandchildren, and nineteen (19) great grandchildren; now 3 therefore, be it
