the traditional way, cooking over a wood-burning stove. She is well-known for her
delicious *Chamorro* Cake; and

WHEREAS, her favorite food dish is fish cooked in any manner, as she is not too keen on eating red meat, her other favorite dishes, include *atuli* (soup made of corn), *gollai åpan lemmai* (bread fruit cooked in coconut milk), taro, bananas, and eating lots of vegetables; and

20 WHEREAS, as a seamstress, *Tan* Ama had no need to buy clothing for her 21 family, sewing all their clothes; and

WHEREAS, although her mobility is very limited today, she loves being outdoors. In her stronger days, she loved gardening vegetables and flowers. Her favorite flower is the pink *Flores Rosa*;

25 WHEREAS, *Tan* Ama is a member of the *Inarajan* Christian Mothers 26 Organization. As a devoted Catholic, praying the novena every three (3) months and
