- WHEREAS, on July 7, 1961, Jesus Q. Ninete, Sr. began his career with the
- 4 government of Guam working for the Department of Public Works (DPW) as a
- 5 Student Trainee; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ninete continued his government of Guam service as a temporary appointment until November 25, 1963, when he was permanently hired as a Trades Helper until his promotion to the position of Clerk III on July 1, 1964; and WHEREAS, five (5) years after his promotion to Clerk III, Mr. Ninete began carving out his career as a Building Inspector for the Department of Public Works Building Permits & Inspection Section, which began on December 28, 1969; and 

WHEREAS, as a Building Inspector, Mr. Ninete's responsibilities included overseeing the initial phase of construction projects, which begins with reviewing plans and specifications, ensuring compliance with zoning and building codes, determining appropriate materials and quality workmanship, and conducting onsite inspection of the structure during its various construction phases; and

WHEREAS, for his commendable performance as a Building Inspector, Mr. Ninete had received a Meritorious Award in September 1971; and

WHEREAS, continuing his ascent through the ranks, on October 3, 1971, Mr. Ninete was promoted to the position of Construction Inspector IV, overseeing the Building Inspectors who worked with him in the DPW Building Permits & Inspection Section; and

WHEREAS, after serving as a Construction Inspector IV for almost eight (8) years, Mr. Ninete was then promoted to the position of Chief Building Inspector on July 1, 1980, where he was instrumental in developing the proposed Notice of Intent to Amend the Guam Building Valuation and Building Permit Fees Schedule in September 2005; and

WHEREAS, after serving more than four (4) years as the Chief Building Inspector, Mr. Ninete was then promoted to the position of Administrator of the Building Permits and Inspection Section on April 5, 1985, where he continued

conducting research work on building materials, design and methods of construction, always keeping abreast of current construction trends, and building techniques, as well as laws that govern the construction industry on Guam and abroad; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ninete was instrumental in providing testimony that contributed to the enactment of the legislation that restored the "DPW Building and Design Fee Account," which would fund the operations of the Division of Engineering, Vertical (Capital Improvement Projects), Building Permits and Inspection Section of the Department of Public Works, which included an appropriation for operational costs; and

WHEREAS, during Fiscal Year 2011 and up until his retirement on April 11, 2012, Mr. Ninete, as the Administrator for the DPW Building Permits and Inspection Section, continued his dedication through collaborative efforts with other government of Guam agencies to capture accurate tax valuation to validate land parcel data and the ability for all agencies to interface electronically, promoting efficiency, and potential revenue enhancing; and

WHEREAS, in addition to receiving a Meritorious Award in 1971, Mr. Ninete received an Outstanding Award in 1981 as a Building Inspector Supervisor; another Outstanding Award in 1982 as a Building Inspector Supervisor; and an Outstanding Award in 2010 as the Administrator for the DPW Building Permits and Inspection Section; now therefore, be it
