3        **WHEREAS, “National Police Week” will be celebrated nationwide from May**  
4        **13 to May 19, 2012, as a tribute to the brave men and women in law enforcement who**  
5        **protect our communities; and**

1       **WHEREAS**, the dedicated officers of the Guam Police Department, the J.D.  
2 Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority of Guam Police, the A.B. Won Pat  
3 International Airport Authority Police, and other local and federal law enforcement  
4 officers enforce the laws of our nation and island every day, placing their lives at risk  
5 to protect and defend our citizens; and

6       **WHEREAS**, with the mounting number of crimes in our community and traffic  
7 violations on our roadways, our police officers and law enforcement personnel work  
8 countless hours, sacrificing their personal and family time to ensure the safety of  
9 others; and

10       **WHEREAS**, these courageous men and women work closely with civilian  
11 personnel in their respective agencies who perform essential functions in support of  
12 the uniformed officers; and

13       **WHEREAS**, many of Guam’s police officers, law enforcement personnel, and  
14 peace officers have died in the line of duty, the ultimate act of selflessness that will be  
15 remembered during “Police Week”; and

16       **WHEREAS**, the brave men and women of law enforcement and their families,  
17 and those who are retired, deserve the public’s recognition for their unwavering  
18 support and service to the people of Guam; now therefore, be it

19       **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Unu Na*  
20 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
21 of Guam, recognize, commend and honor our “Every Day Heroes”, the brave men and

23 Authority of Guam Police, the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Police,

5 through the fair and efficient enforcement of law; and be it further


6 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


