## 1BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I2MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed into law legislation that designated the 15<sup>th</sup> of May, every year, as a special day to honor Peace Officers in communities nationwide, for their commitment and service in the protection of citizens from criminal activities, especially extreme violence and terrorism; and

8 WHEREAS, on this special day set aside to honor Peace Officers, Guam joins 9 communities throughout the nation in paying honor and recognition to the 10 courageous men and women whose mission is enforcing the laws, protecting citizens 11 from injustice, and providing public safety services for all of Guam's people; and

WHEREAS, every single day, Peace Officers throughout the island are asked to place themselves in harm's way to protect the community and to provide for the public's safety; and at times this may require that they risk their lives and pay the ultimate sacrifice, which is at a tremendous cost to the community, but also a valuable service in the protection of our island and its people; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guam will observe "Peace Officers' Memorial Day" on May 15, 2012, which is a time to acknowledge the brave men and women in uniform who have paid the ultimate sacrifice while serving in the line of duty, and have given their lives in the protection of life and property for the people of Guam; and

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 12 13 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, extend a special tribute and Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse' to the 14 15 honorable men and women who proudly served the people of Guam, and gave the ultimate sacrifice of their lives in the line of duty; does extend acknowledgement and 16 17 appreciation to the family members, including the spouses, children and parents, of the fallen Peace Officers who gave their lives in service to the island community; and 18 19 does further encourage the people of Guam to join in the commemoration of "Peace Officers' Memorial Day" on May 15, 2012; and be it further 20
