Relative to recognizing and memorializing the late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca, former Commissioner/Mayor of *Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon*, for his many achievements and accomplishments; and to further extending sincere condolences to his family on his passing.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca was born on July 20, 1940,
4 and he was called to his eternal reward on Saturday, May 19, 2012, at the age of
5 seventy-one (71) years; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca married the former
2 Victorina Mabuti, and they have nine (9) children: Raymond; +Alfredo, Jr.; Esther;
3 Mary Fely; John; Franklin; Richard; Franklin and Beverly; and

4 **WHEREAS**, at the age of sixteen (16), the late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca
5 worked as a bag boy and janitor for Ada's Market from 1956 to 1959; and in 1960, he
6 was promoted to Floor Manager, and he held that position until 1976; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in January 1977, the late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca began his
8 public service career as the Assistant Commissioner of *Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon*,
9 where he served for two (2) terms, until January 1985; and

10 **WHEREAS**, after serving two (2) terms as the Assistant Commissioner of
11 *Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon*, the late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca continued serving
12 his community when he was elected as Commissioner (and then Mayor) of *Tamuning-*
13 *Tumon-Harmon*, where he served from January 1985 to January 1997; and

14 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure as Mayor of *Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon*, the late
15 Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca was instrumental in initiating and completing various
16 projects, such as the completion of the *Tamuning* multi-purpose field; the construction
17 of the indoor gymnasium; the installation of traffic signal lights at the intersection of
18 *Chalan San Antonio* and Farenholt Avenue, and the traffic signal lights at the
19 intersection of Farenholt Avenue and Governor Carlos Camacho Road; and other
20 capital improvement projects, such as the paving of roads in Carlos Heights and the
21 *Harmon* Industrial Park; and sewer and water line upgrades in the upper *Harmon* area;
22 and

23 **WHEREAS**, in addition to performing his municipal duties, the late Honorable
24 Alfredo C. Dungca was actively involved with his community, serving as Chairman of
25 Troop Two Boy Scouts of America; as Member of the Northern Little League Board

1 of Directors; as LBJ Elementary PTA President; and as Board Member of the Hospital
2 Point Development, the Guam Visitors Bureau and the Guam Airport Authority; and

3 **WHEREAS**, late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca had received recognitions and
4 various awards from St. Anthony's Church; the Pacific Star Hotel; the Guam Fire
5 Department; the Department of Education; the Department of Parks and Recreation;
6 Youth with a Mission; Sanctuary, Inc.; the Chief Brodie Memorial School; and the
7 Association of Pacific Island Legislatures; now therefore, be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
9 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
10 of Guam, recognize and memorialize the late Honorable Alfredo C. Dungca, former
11 Commissioner/Mayor of *Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon*, for his many achievements and
12 accomplishments; and does further extend sincere condolences to his family on his
13 passing; and be it further

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
15 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
16 the same be thereafter transmitted to the family of the late Honorable Alfredo C.
17 Dungca; to the Mayors Council of Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I*
18 *Maga'låhen Guåhan*.
