2 his tenure as the Senior USMC Representative to the island of Guam during a difficult
3 time of uncertainty about the direction and final outcome of the Guam military
4 buildup, now known as the Guam military realignment; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Colonel Loynd came to Guam at the height of a distinguished career
6 that has required both military and diplomatic skills, which he gained through
7 education and thorough preparation, including the intensive study of strategy and
8 policy development, as well as Asia-Pacific security. In addition to his demonstrated
9 fluency in the Russian language, Colonel Loynd has been deployed throughout the
10 world in various conflicts and capacities, including Operations Desert Shield/Desert
11 Storm and Iraqi Freedom; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Colonel Loynd has also served as Chief, J5 Strategy Branch, U.S.
13 Forces Korea, Seoul, Republic of Korea; as Deputy Branch Head, Aviation Weapons
14 Requirements, Aviation Department, HQMC; as USMC Aviator and Squadron
15 Commander, EA-6B Prowler, Cherry Point, North Carolina; and as the U.S. Marine
16 Corps Russian/Eurasian Foreign Area Officer; now therefore, be it

22 Godspeed on his departure; and be it further


23 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
