- WHEREAS, in School Year 2011-2012, Ms. Andres continued the "Leave
- 13 your Mark" project efforts after Simon A. Sanchez High School continually
- 14 experienced numerous break-ins, thefts and acts of senseless vandalism leaving
- students without classrooms; her English 12 class began their "Leave Your Mark"
- 16 project by approaching the community and Hotel Nikko Guam to request help in
- 17 providing security for the school, and was given favorable reception and assistance in
- 18 the form of volunteer patrol services; and
