3        **WHEREAS,** Jeanette Guevara Sablan Tanos was born on February 13,  
4   1952, to Francisco B. and Rita G. Sablan and was called to her eternal life on May  
5   21, 2012, at the age of sixty (60); and

1       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos married Emory F. Tanos, and they  
2 have five (5) children: Jason, Joseph, John, Scott and Gwen and seven (7)  
3 grandchildren: Jeremiah, Jakob, Joshua, Jasmin, Jonah, Junyu and Johanna; and

4       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos is one of ten (10) siblings: Johnny,  
5 Joseph, James, Josephine, Jerry, Jesse, Jeffrey, Joyleen, and Jerald; and

6       **WHEREAS**, in June 1970, Jeanette graduated from the Academy of our  
7 Lady of Guam in *Hagåtña* and went on to receive an Associates Degree in Nursing  
8 from the University of Guam in August of 1972; and

9       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos graduated Magna Cum Laude from  
10 the University of North Florida in Jacksonville with a Degree in Nursing,  
11 continued graduate studies at Chapman University in California and the University  
12 of Guam and earned a Master in Human Relations (MHR) Degree from the  
13 University of Oklahoma in Norman with a Primary Focus on Counseling and  
14 Administration in June of 1998; and

15       **WHEREAS**, in September of 2006, the late Jeanette S. Tanos received an  
16 Associates Degree in Occupational Service from the Heritage Institute in  
17 Jacksonville, Florida; and

18       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos holds professional licenses as an  
19 individual, marriage, and family therapist, a registered nurse, and a massage  
20 therapist from boards in Guam and Florida; and

21       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos served our island as the former  
22 director for the Guam Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, and also  
23 as a Public Health Nurse Administrator, responsible for the budget of the Nursing  
24 Bureau; and

25       **WHEREAS**, in 2001, the late Jeanette S. Tanos served on the Guam  
26 Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) Board of Trustees as the Vice Chairperson  
27 and was also the Co-Chairperson for the GMHA QA Committee; and

1       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos also served as Secretary on the  
2 Guam Community Health Center Board of Directors; and

3       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos contributed her time and talent as an  
4 educator as a clinical nursing instructor at the University of Guam's Nursing  
5 Program - Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing Practicum; and

6       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos worked as a psychotherapist,  
7 providing part-time contractual services to the Judiciary of Guam and volunteering  
8 with the Guam Veterans Affairs Clinic; and

9       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos also proudly served in United States  
10 Armed Forces as a Captain in the Nurse Corps for the United States Air Force; and

11       **WHEREAS**, the late Jeanette S. Tanos also contributed to the local  
12 community through her involvement as a community partner to the C-T Transition  
13 Team Subcommittee on Community and Social Welfare; Member of the Human  
14 Trafficking Task Force, Crisis Intervention, and Treatment Subcommittee at the  
15 US District Court of Guam; Consultant to the Guam Board of Allied Health  
16 Examiners' and the Attorney General's Office; Member of the CMHS Mental  
17 Health Consultant and Peer Reviewer Panel; Vice Chairperson of the GMHA  
18 Board of Trustees; Chairperson for the Quality Assurance and Utilization Review  
19 Committee; Member of the Guam Nursing Organization, in addition to serving as  
20 Board of Director in the Guam Nurses Association; Volunteer Mental Health  
21 Provider for the American Red Cross; and Member of the Disability Council; now,  
22 therefore be it;

26 extend sincere condolences to her family on her passing; and be it further


1           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to
