- 1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***  
3        **WHEREAS,** the Lions Clubs International District 204 is a group of twenty-  
4        three (23) Lions Clubs from Guam, Saipan, the Marshall Islands and Pohnpei; the

1 oldest club being the Guam Marianas Lions Club, which has been in existence for  
2 sixty-three (63)\_ years; and

3       **WHEREAS**, the Region 1 of the Lions Club International District 204 is  
4 composed of: the Marianas Lions Club; the *Guåhan* Lions Club; the Paradise Lions  
5 Club; the Stars Lions Club; the Harmony Lions Club; the Asia-Pacific Lions Club; the  
6 *Merizo* Southern Guam Lions Club; the Rainbow Lions Club; the *Galaide* Lions Club;  
7 the *Latte* Stone Lions Club; the Spirit Lions Club; the Rock Lions Club; the New  
8 Horizon Lions Club; the *Isla* Lions Club; the Guamerica Lions Club; the *Tamuning*  
9 Stars Lions Club; the *Gadao* Lions Club; and the Nightingale Lions Club; and

10       **WHEREAS**, the Lions Clubs International is the largest service organization in  
11 the world. While each club adopts a special project, the principal project of each  
12 Lions Club around the world is sight conservation. This is why the Lions are fondly  
13 known as the “Knights of the Blind;” and

14       **WHEREAS**, the Lions Club motto is “We Serve”, and the mission of the Lions  
15 Club is to empower volunteers to serve their communities, to meet humanitarian  
16 needs, to encourage peace, and to promote international understanding through Lions  
17 Clubs; and

18       **WHEREAS**, the official theme of International President Wing-Kun Tam for  
19 Lion Year 2011-2012 is “I Believe,” sending a message to all Lions that anything can  
20 be accomplished when Lions have faith, sincerity, honesty, dedication and teamwork  
21 among them. The Lions Club International District 204 took part in International  
22 President Wing-Kun Tam’s project for Lions to plant a million trees around the world,  
23 and helped to exceed the goal nine (9) times; and

24       **WHEREAS**, for the Lion Year 2011 to 2012, the Lions Clubs of Guam were  
25 active in various community service activities, such as hosting a medical health fair at

3 a child with cerebral palsy; sponsoring a Leo Club whose membership are students  
4 from Southern High School; conducting a youth camp at *Tongan Beach* in *Talofofo*;  
5 participating in the Peace Poster Contest; and giving free eye examinations and  
6 eyeglasses to school children; and

6 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.


