11	Cognatus; and Neline Cruz, Grand Aerarium Odis; and
12	WHEREAS, the Fraternity Grand Council is comprised of the leadership under
13	Frank Blas Aguon, Jr., Grand Magister; Vic Pasetes, Jr., Grand Vitium Magister;
14	Craig C. Cruz, Grand Charta Custos; Allen S. Santos, Grand Aerarium Odis; Elbert G.
15	Piolo, Grand Delectus & Securitas Preafectus; and Senator Dennis Rodriguez, Jr.,
16	Grand Internus Cognatus; and
17	WHEREAS, the successes of each brother and sister in this prestigious
18	organization has been shared with the various communities where DLX is present; and
19	WHEREAS, among the many services contributed by each DLX member to
20	the community includes the adoption of bus stops in conjunction with the Lieutenant
21	Governor's Island Beautification Task Force; participation in the Anti-Bullying
22	Campaign at our schools; the DLX Health and Wellness Campaign; assistance in
23	school beautification in Inarajan; and the DLX Peace Festival in commemoration of
24	the international founding month; and
