1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Alan Sanchez San Nicolas is the proud son of the late Albert and
4 the late Joaquina San Nicolas from the village of *Malessso*, and is married to Sergeant
5 Ann San Nicolas. Sergeants Alan and Ann San Nicolas are the proud parents of Alan
6 Michael and Alex David San Nicolas; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Alan graduated from *Inarajan* High School, and in May 1985 at
8 the age of nineteen (19) years old, he began his government of Guam career at the
9 Department of Corrections (DOC), working in every post of the Department of
10 Corrections; and he was specifically assigned to the Maximum Security Unit and
11 General Population; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 1994, Alan received training with the Department's
13 Corrections Emergency Response Team (CERT);. and he was also a member and
14 team leader of the Special Operations Response Team (SORT) from 1999 to the
15 present; and

16 **WHEREAS**, in October 1998, Alan was promoted to the rank of Corporal and
17 became the Shift Leader for the Post #6 Disciplinary Unit; and a few years later, he
18 was transferred to the Community Correction Center, where he was assigned as the
19 Unit Manager and he was able to move the Center away from the facility compound to
20 *Tiyan*, being able to expand the community services; and

21 **WHEREAS**, on May 19, 2003, Corporal Alan Sanchez San Nicolas was
22 actively involved with the Department of Corrections' Disciplinary Hearing Board,
23 Unit Program Team, and Policy Review Board as a member, and he later became the
24 Chairman; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Corporal Alan Sanchez San Nicolas attended training in the direct
26 supervision of inmates, effective communications, weapons of mass destruction,

1 counter terrorism, and numerous other courses with the Department of
2 Administration's Training Center; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Corporal Alan Sanchez San Nicolas had the privilege of being the
4 only Corrections Officer who attended training at the N.I.C. Administrative
5 Management of Community Corrections Centers in Colorado with Directors, Regional
6 Directors, and Chief Parole Managers; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Corporal Alan Sanchez San Nicolas has been an active player
8 with the DOC's Softball Team since he first started in 1985, until the present; and he
9 has organized participation in numerous Law Enforcement Goodwill Games with the
10 islands of Saipan and Palau, which travels every year to the hosting island; and

11 **WHEREAS**, on February 22, 2006, Corporal San Nicolas was promoted to the
12 rank of Sergeant and was reassigned to the Third Platoon as Assistant Commander
13 and Unit Manager of the General Population (Post #16). He then was later reassigned
14 to the Community Corrections Center as a Unit Manager after the relocation of the
15 center back to the *Mangilao* facility. A few years later, Sergeant San Nicolas was
16 reassigned to the Special Housing Unit; and

17 **WHEREAS**, in 2010, Sergeant Alan Sanchez San Nicolas was transferred to
18 the *Hagåtña* Detention Facility and assigned as the Commander; and shortly
19 thereafter, he returned to the main facility and was assigned to the First Platoon as the
20 Commander; and

21 **WHEREAS**, on June 29, 2012, Sergeant Alan Sanchez San Nicolas officially
22 retired from the government of Guam with a final promotion to the rank of Lieutenant;
23 now therefore, be it

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
25 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
26 of Guam, commend and congratulate Lieutenant Alan Sanchez San Nicolas on the


1 occasion of his retirement from the government of Guam, after thirty (30) years of
