the State University of New York Downstate Medical Center, and at the Kings County
Hospital in Brooklyn, New York. Dr. Zvonik finished her residency in 1978 after
completing thousands of deliveries and cesareans; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Zvonik served at the Fort Defiance Indian Hospital in
Arizona, from 1978 to 1980; and she then worked with the Alaska Native Medical
Center, serving the villages of Nome, Kotzebue, Dillingham, Kanak, Barrow and
Bethel, from 1980 to 1984; and

WHEREAS, Kaaren then joined FHP Utah, and practiced in Utah for ten (10)
years until FHP offered to send her to Guam for two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, after her two (2) years at FHP, Dr. Zvonik decided to stay on Guam, and she then worked at The Doctors Clinic, at PMC Isla Health System, and lastly, with Marianas Physicians Group; now therefore, be it
