3 Elementary Teacher Education from the University of Phoenix; and

5 multiple youth sports events; and she has created communities off and on base since

7           **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett developed the Naval Base Guam Branch of  
8 NAYS (National Alliance Youth Sports Program); and

9           **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett had increased the opportunities for youth during  
10 the summer fitness and summer clinics, and she generated new revenue with the  
11 implementation of dance gear resale items; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett developed a partnership with DODEA  
13 elementary and middle schools to implement an annual sports day for over eight  
14 hundred (800) school children; and

15           **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett spearheaded the training and facilitation of the  
16 Micros RecTrac Computer System, resulting in easier registration and tracking for  
17 youth programs; and

18           **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett had served as the Child Youth Program Director  
19 and the Contracting Officer's Representative for MWR Guam, from July 2010  
20 through July 2012; and


21           **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett leaves us after eight (8) long years and is

2 further


3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


