**Relative to recognizing, congratulating and commending
the Korea Freedom Foundation on the establishment of a
Guam Chapter.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation is a global-level nongovernmental
4 organization that was established in the Republic of Korea to perpetuate free
5 democracy in Korea; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation has more than 1.5 million
7 members world-wide; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation engages in social work and
9 volunteer activities by establishing a strong community spirit, which nurtures a mature
10 and civil society; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation is recognized by the United
12 Nation's Economic and Social Council; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation operates a program that sends
14 college students for overseas voluntary services to spread the spirit of love and sharing
15 around the world in undeveloped countries; and actively engages in global efforts to
16 promote free-democracy; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation currently has branches in sixteen
18 (16) countries, and is currently planning to open branches in seventeen (17) more; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation leads activities, that include civic
20 education for reunification, through debate contests in high schools, and speech
21 competitions on free-democracy; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation actively addresses social issues,
23 such as the nuclear experiments in North Korea, and the human rights of North
24 Korean refugees; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the Korea Freedom Foundation is chartering the first Guam
26 Chapter on July 27, 2012, led by former Korean Association of Guam President, Mr.
27 Philip C. Ahn; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ahn currently serves as the advisor to the Korean Association
29 of Guam; and

30 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ahn promotes and shares the Korean culture on Guam by
31 participating in local celebrations and activities, as well as in various local community
32 projects; and

33 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ahn, during his tenure as the President of the Korean
34 Association of Guam, established “Korean Day” on October 3, 1990; now therefore,
35 be it

36 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
37 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
38 of Guam, recognize, congratulate and commend the Korea Freedom Foundation on
39 the establishment of a Guam Chapter; and be it further


40 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
