3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Eutiquio T. Velasco was born on April 15, 1939, in**
4 **Pampanga, Philippines. He is married to Elizabeth V. Velasco, and they are**

5 blessed with five (5) children: Paul, Shunette, Jocelyn, Joleen, and Tricia; and they
6 are also the proud grandparents of twelve (12) wonderful grandchildren; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Eutiquio T. Velasco began his government of Guam
8 career on October 15, 1984, working as a Maintenance Supervisor with the Guam
9 Police Department (GPD). Despite the manpower support limited to volunteers and
10 parolees assigned by the Department of Corrections, Mr. Velasco was responsible
11 for ensuring the proper maintenance of GPD's administrative facilities; and

12 **WHEREAS**, on December 16, 1997, in recognition of his outstanding
13 contributions, Mr. Velasco was awarded a Certificate of Commendation for
14 assisting the Guam Police Department and the residents of Guam in the recovery
15 from the devastating impact of Super Typhoon *Paka*; and

16 **WHEREAS**, during the 2011 "Guam Police Week" celebrations, Mr.
17 Velasco received the agency's "Civilian Employee of the Year" Award, in
18 recognition of his unyielding commitment and exceptional service to the Guam
19 Police Department; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in the same year, Mr. Velasco was also recognized by
21 Governor Edward B. Calvo as an outstanding employee of the government of
22 Guam. Accordingly, Mr. Velasco was one (1) of only thirteen (13) employees of
23 the Guam Police Department who received the prestigious MagPRO Award; and

24 **WHEREAS**, after serving for more than twenty-eight (28) years as a
25 Maintenance Supervisor with the Guam Police Department, Mr. Velasco retired
26 from government of Guam service on July 28, 2012; now therefore, be it


27 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*

31 Supervisor, after more than twenty-eight (28) years of dedicated service to the


32 Guam Police Department; and does further extend a most sincere *Un Dangkolo Na*
