WHEREAS, Sanctuary, Inc. has grown into a community-based organization which exists to improve the quality of life for Guam's youth, to promote reconciliation during times of family conflicts, to foster the development of responsible community members, and to advocate for their needs in an effort to preserve family unity by providing: twenty-four (24)-hour crisis intervention services, temporary safe refuge during family conflicts and abuse, supportive counseling for youth and families, and outreach, education and prevention programs; and
