**Relative to recognizing and congratulating the Domino Lux (DLX) International Fraternity and Sorority on the occasion of its Thirty-eighth (38<sup>th</sup>) Year Anniversary celebration of the founding of its original chapter; and to further extending a sincere *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* and *Maraming Salamat Po'* to the brotherhood and sisterhood members of DLX for their active involvement throughout the island community, and for their charitable contributions to people in need on Guam and abroad.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES *I***  
2   ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

1       **WHEREAS**, Domino Lux (DLX) International is an elite international  
2 fraternity and sorority, which was established for the purpose of strategically focusing  
3 on the promotion of the DLX core values of brotherhood and sisterhood, and the  
4 intellectual, cultural, physical and spiritual welfare of its members; and

5       **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux Fraternity was originally founded on September  
6 20, 1974, at the De La Salle University in Manila, Philippines, by fourteen (14)  
7 aspiring professionals, in order to extend the camaraderie among its members during  
8 their college years and beyond. Subsequently, a member of the DLX Brotherhood  
9 established the Domino Lux International Fraternity in an effort to share its legacy and  
10 values worldwide, and to further promote the brotherhood in the advancement of  
11 personal and professional success; and

12       **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity and Sorority advocate  
13 and promote the symbolism of brotherhood and sisterhood, to include: individualism  
14 within the framework of cooperation; lifetime friendship among its members; provide  
15 support and encouragement in the personal and professional endeavors of its  
16 members; promote the strength and foundation of the family as the core to a  
17 successful and fruitful life; and promote the direct involvement of its members in their  
18 participation in, and support of, community activities; and

19       **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity and Sorority's guiding  
20 principles center on the following goals: (1) to promote the spirit of camaraderie  
21 among its members; (2) to inculcate in every member the value of scholarship, and act  
22 as a guiding force in his/her pursuit of their chosen career, making him/her fully  
23 prepared for his/her current and future state; (3) to improve the social attitudes and  
24 conduct of each member; (4) to provide a medium in developing and polishing the  
25 potentialities in every member; (5) to develop the physical and mental well-being of

1 each member; and (6) to uplift spiritual awareness in every member to achieve a well-  
2 rounded personality; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, was  
4 informally established on Guam on June 18, 2008, with eighteen (18) original  
5 founding members of the Chapter; and in just a short period of four (4) years, it has  
6 increased its membership to more than eight hundred (800) brothers and sisters, which  
7 has been credited much to the ability of each of its individual members to aggressively  
8 recruit new members because of the organization's dynamic support, internally, of  
9 each other and of its support to the island community. The Guam Chapter has been  
10 recognized as the Domino Lux International Fraternity Headquarters; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter,  
12 expanded its foundational base in January 2012 with four (4) founding members, to  
13 include the establishment of a Domino Lux International Sorority, Guam, which  
14 similarly promotes and advocates its core values and principles among its female  
15 members on Guam, in the advancement of sisterhood and community, and has grown  
16 to close to one hundred (100) members; and

17 **WHEREAS**, since its initial establishment, the Domino Lux International  
18 Fraternity and Sorority, Guam Chapter, has extended tremendous support among its  
19 members and the local community to include, but not limited to, the following  
20 activities: regular gatherings of its members for friendship; the DLX Annual Red  
21 Carpet Ball in celebration of the organization's founding day; the participation of its  
22 members in numerous local sports activities, i.e., basketball, softball, billiards, boxing,  
23 and other sports; regular family day gatherings; the annual religious retreats for its  
24 members during the Lenten season; the sponsoring of sports clinics for the island's  
25 children and youth; the cleaning and painting of some of Guam's public middle  
26 schools and bus stops; monetary donations for flood victims in the Philippines; the

1 DLX Annual Red Carpet Ball fundraisers, where proceeds are distributed to several of  
2 Guam's non-profit community organizations; fundraisers in support of family  
3 members who require medical treatment; and numerous other events and activities  
4 highlighting the active support and contribution that Domino Lux International  
5 Fraternity and Sorority, Guam Chapter, provides to the people of Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, members of the Domino Lux International Fraternity and  
7 Sorority, Guam Chapter, have also participated in the adoption of bus stops, in  
8 conjunction with the Island Beautification Task Force; have participated in the Anti-  
9 Bullying Campaign at various schools on Guam; have established the DLX Health  
10 and Wellness Campaign; and have also assisted with school beautifications projects;  
11 and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity and Sorority, Guam  
13 Chapter, celebrated its second (2<sup>nd</sup>) year of the DLX Peace Festival, an event  
14 promoting brotherhood and sisterhood by commemorating the month of June as the  
15 founding month of DLX International; now therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*  
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
18 of Guam, recognize and congratulate the Domino Lux (DLX) International Fraternity  
19 and Sorority on the occasion of its Thirty-eighth (38<sup>th</sup>) Year Anniversary celebration  
20 of the founding of its original chapter; and does further extend a sincere *Un Dångkolo*  
21 *Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* and *Maraming Salamat Po'* to the brotherhood and sisterhood  
22 members of DLX for their wonderful support and active involvement throughout the  
23 island community, and for their charitable contributions to people in need on Guam  
24 and abroad; and does extend its best wishes to the organization for continued success  
25 in its future endeavors; and be it further
