11 January 19, 1998; and

13 Special Achievement Recognition Award, on January 16, 2009; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Camacho has a daughter, Georgette Marie, who is married to  
15 James A Ulloa; and is blessed with three (3) grandchildren: Caleb, Bryce and  
16 Gabriella; now therefore, be it

25 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of


- 1 the same be thereafter transmitted to Ms. Remedios M. Camacho and her family; and


