5 Revenue and Taxation (DRT); and has been employed with the Department for the  
6 past forty (40) years; and

7       **WHEREAS**, on September 10, 1972, Mrs. Benavente began her career at the  
8 Department of Revenue and Taxation (DRT), government of Guam, working as a  
9 Clerk II, after transferring from the Guam Department of Labor; and

10       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Benavente worked as a Clerk II with the DRT Income Tax  
11 Assistance & Processing Branch (ITAPB) until November 29, 1976, when she was  
12 promoted to Clerk IV within the ITAPB; and

13       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Benavente was promoted to Tax Processing Technician I,  
14 and then reclassified to a Revenue Officer I in the ITAPB, on July 7, 1980; and she  
15 was again promoted on July 8, 1982, to a Revenue Officer III in the ITAPB; and

16       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Benavente then was reassigned to the Business Privilege  
17 Tax Branch (BPTB), where she served as a Business Privilege Tax Service Specialist  
18 II, from October 2, 1984 until July 17, 1986; and


19       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Janice Salas Benavente is married to the Honorable Andrew

3 recognition of their support of her service to the people of Guam; and be it further


4 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
