WHEREAS, Mrs. Cecilia "Cis" A.T. Lizama began her career in the field of
accounting when she first became an Accounting Clerk with FHP, Inc., in 1980; and

by the time she left the company in 1989, she had worked her way up to the position
 of Bookkeeper III; and

WHEREAS, while being gainfully employed, Cis continued in her pursuit of a
higher education; and in May 1991, Cis obtained her BBA in Accounting from the
University of Guam; and

6 WHEREAS, in 1991, Cis was employed with Deloitte and Touche, where she 7 held the position of Staff Auditor, preparing financial statements, and performing field 8 work of audit engagements in governmental and health maintenance organizations, as 9 well as hotel and retail entities; and

WHEREAS, in November 1995, Cis entered public service, serving as the
 Chief Fiscal Officer for the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC), a position
 that she currently holds; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 1997, Cis became a Certified Public Accountant
 (CPA) in and for the territory of Guam, receiving her certificate from the Guam Board
 of Accountancy; and

WHEREAS, after joining the Public Defender Service Corporation, Cis was
 faced with the tremendous task of restoring credibility and order to the Fiscal
 Division, particularly with regards to its financial records; and

WHEREAS, during her tenure, standard operating procedures and policies
 were developed and implemented so that the PDSC's Fiscal Division was brought into
 compliance with accounting and other financial mandates; and

WHEREAS, there was a time when the PDSC was criticized and was known for being "problematic" with regards to its responsiveness to other government agencies' inquiries relative to financial matters; but with Cis' dedication to the job at hand, this criticism has since discontinued; and

WHEREAS, despite being given additional responsibilities, such as the
 Domestic Violence Program and the establishment of the Office of the Alternate
 Public Defender, Cis never faltered in her commitment and diligence to her duties and
 responsibilities as the Corporation's money manager; and

5 WHEREAS, her hard work, dedication and loyalty to the mission of the PDSC 6 are best exemplified in the "CLEAN" audits that the Corporation has consistently 7 received under her watch; inclusive of the timely submittals of required financial 8 reports, prompt payments to vendors, and the punctual deposits for PDSC payroll; and

9 WHEREAS, Cis maintains professional affiliations, to include serving as a
10 Member of the Association of Government Accountants, Guam Chapter; and

11 WHEREAS, Cis is also an active community leader, serving as a Lector for the 12 *Niño Perdido Y Sagrada Familia* Church Parish in *Asan*; and she is also a Member of 13 the *Una Voce* Choir for the *Blessed Diego Luis de San Vitores* Church Parish in 14 *Tumon*; and

WHEREAS, Cis is married to Eloy S. Lizama, and they have a son, Elijah
James Lizama; now therefore, be it
