WHEREAS, Florenzo P. Fejeran, also known as Larry, Chief, Ref, Pare and Primo, began his career with the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) in September 1976, working as a General Helper; and

1 **WHEREAS**, throughout his thirty-six (36) years with the PDSC, Larry has
2 excelled through the ranks, holding a total of twelve (12) different positions,
3 beginning as a General Helper and working his way up to becoming the Chief
4 Investigator in 1994; and

5 **WHEREAS**, by keeping an open mind toward his colleagues, as well as his
6 professional encounters, Larry developed his people skills, allowing him to succeed in
7 life; and

8 **WHEREAS**, knowing early on that an education beyond high school would
9 further develop his career and personal well-being, Larry attended the University of
10 Guam as a Regent Scholar and graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's degree in
11 Criminal Justice; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Larry is a firm believer in the self-education attitude to develop
13 one's career; and that learning the roles and responsibilities of the whole work
14 environment makes for better leadership; and

15 **WHEREAS**, six (6) years following his graduation from the University of
16 Guam, Larry became the Chief Investigator and successfully held that position with
17 honor and performance beyond expectations, without incident or adverse action; and

18 **WHEREAS**, as Chief Investigator, Larry led the Investigation Section with
19 dignity and equal respect toward his subordinates, always lending an ear or a helping
20 hand through the tough times; and

21 **WHEREAS**, while serving as Chief Investigator, Larry excelled as a liaison
22 between the Public Defender Service Corporation and other government agencies, as
23 well as private parties, in obtaining information pertinent toward the goals and
24 objectives of case investigations; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Larry's work experiences gave him the ability to understand and
26 evaluate issues and circumstances that naturally transpire in the work environment,

1 allowing him to resolve conflicts or issues so that the mission of the Public Defender
2 Service Corporation continues to move forward; now therefore, be it

4 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
5 of Guam, commend and congratulate Mr. Florenzo "Larry" P. Fejeran on the occasion

7 extend a warm and sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for his thirty-six
