1       **WHEREAS**, the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port (Port) was  
2 established as a public corporation and autonomous government agency by the  
3 enactment of Public Law 13-87 on October 1975; and

4       **WHEREAS**, over the last three (3) decades, the Port has developed into a  
5 major transshipment center for the Western Pacific Region, providing full services to  
6 ocean passenger, cargo and fishing vessels; and

7       **WHEREAS**, in Fiscal Year 2012, the Port processed more than one million one  
8 hundred thousand (1,100,000) revenue tons of cargo, providing vital goods to the  
9 people of Guam; and

10       **WHEREAS**, the Port continues to support the neighboring islands of  
11 Micronesia, transshipping approximately twenty-nine million (29,000,000) gallons of  
12 fuel and five hundred thousand (500,000) revenue tons of essential goods throughout  
13 Micronesia; and

14       **WHEREAS**, three hundred seventy-four (374) employees operate and maintain  
15 five (5) cargo handling piers, a container yard, two (2) marinas, and a harbor of  
16 refuge; and

17       **WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors, Management and Employees of the Jose  
18 D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port remain committed and steadfast in taking on the  
19 enormous challenges of modernizing the Port in anticipation of the island's organic  
20 growth; now therefore, be it

21       **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*  
22 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
23 people of Guam, congratulate and commend the dedicated Employees, Management  
24 and Board of Directors of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port on the occasion  
25 of its Thirty-seventh (37th) Year Anniversary, and on the observance of "Port Week"  
26 from October 15 to 19, 2012; and does further encourage the people of Guam to


1 actively participate in the many activities related to the celebration of the Port's

9 the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


