- 6 known, will always be remembered for his loyalty, sincerity, humor, and sense of

WHEREAS. Bill Neilsen is the owner of the Guam Harley-Davidson dealership, and he passed away on Wednesday, October 17, 2012; and the news of his death shocked his family and friends, who had developed a close relationship with Bill over the years; and WHEREAS, under Bill's leadership, the Guam Harley-Davidson was established as the only authorized Harley-Davidson full line dealership within the 6 Mariana Islands region. The Guam Harley-Davidson provided a complete line of 7 8 genuine Harley-Davidson motorcycles, parts, accessories, clothing, and collectibles; 9 and WHEREAS, Bill was affectionately known by his family and friends to have a 10 heart of gold. Bill was a pied piper in caring for our community; he was a man who 11 never said no to the community, and he continued to give and didn't want anything in 12 13 return; and 14 WHEREAS, Bill and the Guam Harley-Davidson had always contributed to the 15 Salvation Army, the Guam Memorial Hospital, the Naval Hospital, the Saint Dominic's Senior Care Home, the Fisher House, the Special Olympics, and the Alee 16 17 Shelter; and one thing his friends say is that Bill never said no to fundraisers - he was 18 always there helping out, and calling Guam his home; and 19 WHEREAS, another display of Bill's compassion for the community was his unselfish decision to allow vendors to sell their items in the parking lot surrounding 20 21 the Harley Davidson shop free of charge; Bill was a man who gave a lot; and

WHEREAS, through one of his community outreach programs, Bill helped to 1 establish the H.O.G. Mariana Islands Chapter Associated, with the Guam Harley-2 Davidson. Through Bill's efforts, the group conducted many fundraisers and donated 3 to local and off-island charities; and on the second (2nd) Sunday of each month, the 4 group conducted a variety of activities to promote goodwill in the community, and 5 fellowship among Harley riders; and 6 WHEREAS, on the day that Bill passed away, the sounds of Harley Davidson 7 8 motorcycles roared at the overpass along Route 16 near the spot where Bill had lost his life, as his family and friends gathered at the site and placed a wreath in his honor; 9 10 and WHEREAS, Bill was loved by many people, and he will be greatly missed by 11 12 all who knew him; now therefore, be it **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 13 14 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, recognize and honor the late Arthur Walter "Bill" Neilsen, Jr., for his 15 16 invaluable contributions to the people of Guam, and extend Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase' to him for his commitment and compassion for the community; and does 17 18 further express sincere condolences to his family and friends on his passing; and be it 19 further
