BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle was born on January 1, 1965, in San Jose, California, and is married to Monica Blaz Wintterle; and are the proud parents of four (4) children: Jacqueline, Phillip, Christopher and Victoria; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle began his career in public service with
2 the government of Guam, serving as a Police Officer I with the Guam Police
3 Department from February 25, 1985, to September 29, 1989; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in October 1989, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle began working for
5 the Judiciary of Guam as an Alternative Sentencing Officer I, a position which was
6 changed to Deputy Marshal I a few days later. After a year, Mr. Wintterle was
7 promoted to Deputy Marshal II, and three (3) years later he was promoted to Deputy
8 Marshal III. On September 30, 1995, Mr. Wintterle was promoted to Deputy Marshal
9 Supervisor and served as the Acting Deputy Chief Marshal on three (3) occasions -
10 from September 8 to 17, 2003; from September 23 to December 24, 2012; and from
11 January 4 to 17, 2006. Whenever necessary, Mr. Winterle served as Acting Chief
12 Marshal of the Court; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle was a recipient of the Pedro “Doc”
14 Sanchez Scholarship and received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Public
15 Administration on December 19, 1997; and three (3) years later, on December 17,
16 2000, he earned a Master of Public Administration Degree from the University of
17 Guam in *Mangilao*; and

18 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure with the Unified Judiciary of Guam, Mr.
19 Michael Lee Wintterle received a variety of trainings that served him well as an
20 employee of the Court. In 2002, his training included the Domestic Violence Train-
21 the-Trainer Program; the Monadock Expandable Baton Basic Course; and the Combat
22 Tracking Levels 1 and II Course. In 2004, Mr. Wintterle completed training which
23 included: Instructor courses for OCAT, PATH, and MEB, and Judicious Use of
24 Deadly Force Training. The following year, in 2005, Mr. Wintterle received training
25 from the Leadership Institute in Judicial Education and Supervisory Training on
26 Performance Appraisals. In 2006, Mr. Wintterle received training for the 2006 Pacific

1 Law Enforcement Drug Summit; in 2007, for the PJC 2nd Court Administrators
2 Conference; and in 2008, the Dignitary Protection Course, Supervision and
3 Leadership Training, and EEO/Sexual Harassment Supervisory Training; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle was acknowledged for his hard work
5 and dedication through many commendations, to include a Commendation for
6 participating in the Security provided in the Grand Opening of the Guam Judicial
7 Center, on November 11, 1991; a Commendation on Warrant of Arrest Search, on
8 August 5, 1993; and a Letter of Commendation regarding Jury Sequestration, on June
9 12, 2000; and

10 **WHEREAS**, after twenty-seven (27) years, seven (7) months and eight (8) days
11 of service with the Guam Police Department and the Unified Judiciary of Guam, Mr.
12 Michael Lee Wintterle retired from government of Guam service on October 5, 2012,
13 as Deputy Marshal Supervisor, Unified Judiciary of Guam; now therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
15 *Lihe slaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihe slaturan Guåhan* and the people
16 of Guam, commend and congratulate Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle on the occasion of
17 his retirement from the government of Guam, after dedicating more than twenty-seven
18 (27) years of service to the Guam Police Department and the Unified Judiciary of
19 Guam; and does further extend a most sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to
20 his family in recognition of their support of his service to the people of Guam as a
21 Deputy Marshal Supervisor; and be it further
