3 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated, was established in 1971 by Father
4 Robert Phelps and Mr. Luis Martinez, who recognized the importance of providing
5 youth-oriented programs and services on Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the primary mission of Sanctuary is: “Helping Youth and
2 Families Help Themselves”; and

3 **WHEREAS**, since its creation, Sanctuary has remained at the forefront of
4 providing comprehensive services to runaway, homeless, and troubled youth and
5 their families. Throughout the years, Sanctuary has continually expanded its
6 programs to better address the needs of our island's children who confront issues,
7 such as physical and emotional abuse, sexual abuse, gang involvement, negative
8 peer pressure, and alcohol and substance abuse. With a firm foundation, our
9 children and youth will be better able to face the challenges of the future; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated, continuously strives to provide
11 support programs, that now include a twenty-four (24) hour Crisis Hotline; a
12 COED Emergency Shelter; a Transitional Living Program; the *Sagan Na’Homlo*
13 *Para I Manhoben*, for youth battling chemical dependency; case management
14 services; the *Ayuda Para I Komunidat* AmeriCorps Program; the Street Outreach
15 Program; the Relationship Intelligence Project; the Youth Embracing Sanctuary
16 (YES) Crew positive youth development program; the *Fan Macho’cho* Economic
17 Development-Aquaculture and Healing Farms Organic Farming Project; the
18 Parenting Skills and Support group; the Adult Anger Management and Youth
19 Anger Management Programs; programs that address Tobacco Cessation and Self-
20 Esteem; Drug and Alcohol Education and Treatment groups; and HIV/STD testing
21 and education; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary has instilled values, built character, and provided
23 education for the youth of Guam, and their families; and

24 **WHEREAS**, November 2012 will mark the Forty-First (41st) Year
25 Anniversary of Sanctuary, Incorporated, and Sanctuary encourages island residents
