WHEREAS, as an advocate for Veterans, Art is the founder, editor and publisher of the *Guam Veterans Magazine*, a quarterly publication for the Guam Veteran community; and he began the *Guam Vet Talk Show*, a radio talk show that provides a venue for Veterans to bring up issues affecting them, and to engage in dialogue and to share information with the community; and he has assisted numerous Veterans in initiating their applications for Veterans Benefits for service-related disabilities, as well as being actively involved with the planning for the annual Veterans Day ceremonies, and other activities aimed at helping fellow Veterans; and
