Today, the company is comprised of sixty (60) Haumana 2 3 (students) members in Natibu on Guam; thirty (30) members in the Kulu Natibu 4 Dance Squad at the Agueda Johnston Middle School; twenty-six (26) members in the 5 Pacific Fantasies Dance Company; fifty (50) members in Yokohama, Japan; and 6 eighty (80) members in Osaka, Japan, ranging in ages from four (4) to fifty (50) years 7 old; and WHEREAS, Dr. Bengie Santiago was an original member of the Taotao Tano 8 9 Cultural Dancers, under the tutelage of Uncle Frank Rabon, and Dr. Bengie continues 10 to pass on the knowledge he has absorbed to his students; and 11 WHEREAS, "Uncle Bengie", as he is affectionately and respectfully known, 12 has taught his students the ways of respect and discipline, which are vital components 13 to the success of the *Natibu* Dance Company and its legacy; and participating in community activities which contribute to a positive growing environment for the 14 15 children is a hallmark of the *Natibu* Dance Academy; and 16 WHEREAS, among its many achievements, the *Natibu* Dance Academy was honored with the Maga'Lahi Performing Arts Award; and on May 20, 2005, Uncle 17 18 Bengie Santiago was nominated and selected to receive the *Hafa Adai* Spirit Award, 19 which is given to an individual who has contributed and dedicated his life to teaching, 20 promoting and preserving the island's culture and heritage, and the family values of the Chamorro people; and 21 22 WHEREAS, through the *Natibu* Dance Company, Dr. Santiago takes pride in 23 the promotion and preservation of not only the cultures of the Pacific, but also and 24 most importantly, the culture of the *Chamorro* people; and 25 WHEREAS, Hawaii's Golden Treasure, late the Uncle George 26 Lanakilakeikiahiali'i Na'ope, world renowned Kahuna Nui, Kumu Hula Master, and
