- WHEREAS, Mr. Paul M. Fisher was born on April 25, 1947, in Atlantic
- 4 City, New Jersey. He has been married to Aurea (Auring) Bolanos Fisher for
- 5 forty-three (43) years, and they have four (4) children: Lehua, Erika, Katryn and
- 6 Christopher; and are also blessed with two (2) grandchildren: Kyle and Liam; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Fisher graduated Phi Beta Kappa, magna cum laude from 2 the University of Washington, in 1973, with a B.A. in Japanese Regional Studies; 3 and he received his Juris Doctorate from the Georgetown University Law Center in 4 1978, and he is a member of the District of Columbia Bar; and WHEREAS, Paul has served as the Counsel for the Commander, Naval 5 6 Forces Marianas/Joint Region Marianas Guam since July 2001; and 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Fisher has provided exemplary legal advice relating to the 8 issues that bridge the partnership between the military community and the people 9 of Guam, to include providing legal research relative to the Guam Excess Lands 10 Act, the Ancestral Lands Program, the Guam "Priority for Excess Property" Act, and the Chamorro Land Trust Program. His knowledge and background provided 11 12 a better understanding of how these land issues affect the growth of the anticipated 13 military buildup, and the relations between the government of Guam and the Department of Defense; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Paul has become well-versed in the provisions of the Guam 16 Organic Act relating to taxation and custom issues that affect the men and women 17 in the Armed Forces stationed on Guam, in order to assist them and their families 18 as they transition to Guam; and 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Fisher has actively participated as the Navy's local 20 spokesperson regarding the Legal Support Working Group, pursuant to the recent 21 enactment of the Guam Beverage Container Deposit Recycling Act (Guam P.L. 22 30-221), that includes the military's commitment to participate in this joint effort 23 in improving Guam's environment; and 24 WHEREAS, in 2010, Mr. Fisher was one of the founding members and an 25 officer of the "Island Success through Learning Association (ISLA), Inc." 26 organization, that distributes backpacks filled with school supplies to needy 1 children in the public schools of Guam. This effort has distributed more than five

2 thousand (5,000) backpacks to the students of Guam's public school system; and

WHEREAS, from 2009 to 2012, Mr. Fisher has served as a Judge of the Guam High School Mock Trials in collaboration with the Guam Bar Association during the Law Week events; and

WHEREAS, from 2008 up to the present, Mr. Fisher has served as a Catechist at his parish of the Our Lady of Lourdes Church and the Santa Bernadita Chapel in *Yigo*, preparing adults desiring to enter into the Catholic faith through the "Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults", also known as the RCIA program; and he also serves as a Lector and Eucharistic minister at the Saint Michael's parish at Andersen Air Force Base; now therefore, be it
