BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, Mrs. Ana Fernandez Alave was born on November 5, 1950, in Pangasinan, Philippines. She has been married to Mr. Rogelio L. Alave for thirty-four (34) years, and they have two (2) children: Annaliza and Rochelle Alave Diaz;

1 and they are also blessed with two (2) grandchildren: Rylan John and Xavier Rai;

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Ana Alave currently holds the position of Financial
4 Technician for the Commander, Joint Region Marianas Guam, since October 1,
5 2010; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in August 1974, Ana acquired her Bachelor's Degree in
7 Business Administration and Management from the University of the East in
8 Manila, Philippines; and

9 **WHEREAS**, from October 1985 to 1997, Mrs. Alave had held a position as
10 a Checkout Cashier of the Defense Commissary Agency at the Department of the
11 Navy; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 1997, Mrs. Alave was assigned to the position of Financial
13 Technician, and she has served in the same position until her retirement; and

14 **WHEREAS**, while serving in the Financial Technician position, Ana had
15 provided sound oversight of various Funds Control Authorization (FCA)
16 documents totaling Eight (8) Million Dollars; she balanced all accounts at fiscal
17 year's end; she assisted in developing fiscal closeout guidance to assist all base
18 agencies with budget execution; and she verified, audited and certified over one
19 hundred (100) Request for Purchase forms, ensuring delivery to Contracting in less
20 than twenty-four (24) hours; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Ana also developed an automated control log for AF Form 9,
22 she identified purchase orders, she ensured funds were properly obligated to cover
23 payments, she reconciled the accounting database daily, and she validated and
24 certified all purchase orders and financial documents through the Automated
25 Business Services System; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Alave also played a key role in assisting the Wing IG,
2 PACAF, and AMC to resolve issues and complaints concerning unpaid bills, and
3 allowed the Wing to operate with uninterrupted service; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Ana was also responsible for minimizing and reducing interest
5 penalty payments, which helped increase wing funding flexibility, and maintained
6 unpaid invoices below seventeen percent (17%); and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ana was instrumental in her Accounting Liaison Office (ALO)
8 Section winning the Quality Assurance Award for two (2) quarters, beating out
9 other sections in monthly performance indicators by ten percent (10%), surpassing
10 HQ's standards; and she was recognized by leadership as the backbone of the
11 ALO; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 2009, Mrs. Ana F. Alave won the "Employee of the Year"
13 award with her following contributions to the 36th Airbase Wing Comptroller: she
14 managed the \$8.1 Million Dollars Base Government Purchase Card Program,
15 maintaining one hundred nineteen (119) accounts, and ensured timely and accurate
16 monthly payments; she expertly supported the \$33 Million Dollars Contingency
17 operations, and the \$1.8 Million Dollars in GPC loads to enable the Bomber,
18 Fighter, and Tanker and AEF missions; she has committed the \$6.5 Million Dollars
19 Red Horse funds to build up the PRTC-NWF state of the art facility training; and
20 she corrected over \$4.5 Thousand Dollars in financial transactions with ninety-nine
21 percent (99%) accuracy; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Alave is an active member of the Pangasinan Community
23 Association and the San Carlos Association of Guam. She has also participated in
24 other community services, such as disaster assistance events, the American Red
25 Cross, and the University of Guam Scholarship Program; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ana completed six (6) CPE credit hours trained on Air Force
2 and Navy topics ready for successful Joint Region Migration in 2010; now
3 therefore, be it

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
6 people of Guam, commend and congratulate Mrs. Ana Fernandez Alave on the
7 occasion of her retirement after twenty-seven (27) years of government service;
8 and does further extend a warm *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to her for her
9 dedicated services in assisting the needs of our island community; and be it further

10 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
