He participated in 11 various training courses during his years working at DPHSS, to include training from the Guam Environmental Protection Agency on Lead-based Paint, in 1999; 12 13 training on the "Control of Hazardous Emergency Safety Course", where he 14 participated in the "Incident Response Terrorist Bombings Awareness Training Course" and attended the "Hazardous Waste Operation and Emergency Response 15 16 Refresher Training," in 2003; in addition, he also attended an "Asbestos Worker 17 Refresher Course," in 2004; he took a course from the Department of Homeland Security, entitled "Radiological and Nuclear Fundamental Briefing," in 2006; and 18 19 he participated in "Hazardous Waste Operation and Emergency Response 20 Training," in 2008; and WHEREAS, Mr. Benavente excelled in his work and performed very 21 22 professionally.
