BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, Ms. Lillian Chargualaf was born on October 15, 1941, at the U.S. Naval Hospital, Guam; and she is the daughter of Rosario and Jesus V. Santos from *Yona*; and

WHEREAS, Lillian has five (5) children: Raynard, Raul, Ruth, Romell and †Ronny; and additionally, she has been blessed with nineteen (19) grandchildren and seven (7) great grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 1980, Ms. Chargualaf was hired at the U.S. Naval Hospital, Guam, and worked as a Medical Transcriber and Medical Records Reviewer; and she worked there until 1987; and

WHEREAS, in 1987, Lillian moved to Washington State and worked as a Medical Transcriber at the Harrison County Memorial Hospital in Bremerton, Washington; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1990, Lillian was hired at the U.S. Naval Hospital in
2 Bremerton, Washington, as a Medical Transcriber, and transcribed x-rays, operation
3 reports, and medical reports; and she was then promoted to transcribe for medical
4 boards; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 1994, Lillian moved back to Guam after having been away for
6 close to five (5) years; and she was hired as a Medical Records Technician,
7 transcribing medical reports dictated by the physicians at the U.S. Naval Hospital
8 Guam; and

9 **WHEREAS**, on September 7, 2003, Lillian was promoted as a Medical
10 Records Technician to administratively oversee the ambulatory procedure records and
11 same day surgery records, as the medical transcription was outsourced; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Lillian was also detailed as a scanner when coding was
13 outsourced to scan to the off-island coders until this function was finalized; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Chargualaf's now plans to do some travelling to visit her
15 children and siblings; to volunteer at the Guam Memorial Hospital; and mostly to take
16 care of her health during her retirement; now therefore, be it

18 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
