**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA' TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:**

- 1       **WHEREAS**, a group of fifteen (15) representatives from Japan
- 2       visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect and prayer for those
- 3       who died during World War II; and
- 4       **WHEREAS**, those representatives visited the War in the Pacific
- 5       National Park, Naval Station, Gaan Point, Manenggon Memorial Park
- 6       and Yigo Memorial in order to better understand the horrors of war and
- 7       its effects on both the soldiers who fought it and the innocent civilians
- 8       caught in its wake; and

9           **WHEREAS**, it is hoped that this will continue to be an annual

10   trip, and that the tribute paid by these representatives will shine as an

11   example that will encourage other groups and organizations from Japan

12   to make similar trips; and

13           **WHEREAS**, *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, has been instrumental in

14   trying to heal the wounds of World War II and tensions over the war

15   between the people of Japan, Guam, and the United States, and has held

16   ceremonies and tributes in the past years with that noble aim; and

17           **WHEREAS**, the *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, along with its

18   president, Mr. Kensuke Haga, and coordinator Mr. Kosuke Haga, have

19   worked extremely hard to move towards these goals and especially to

20   help organize this trip by Planning K Group representatives; now,

21   therefore, be it

22           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does

23   hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, highly commend and thank the

24   Planning K Group, Japan for visiting Guam and the World War II sites,

25 and honoring those who died at those sites, with their prayer and
