- WHEREAS, Johnson Controls Inc. was first conceptualized in 1885,
- 2 with the innovative invention of the first electric room thermostat; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Johnson Controls Inc. has grown exponentially since
- 4 then, as the company is now known internationally as a diversified
- technology and industrial leader, serving customers in over one
- 6 hundred and fifty (150) countries; and

WHEREAS, Johnson Controls Inc. produces quality products, 7 services, and solutions to optimize energy and operational efficiencies; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, Johnson Controls Inc. firmly believes in the Triple 10 Bottom Line: economic prosperity; social responsibility; and 11 environmental stewardship; and 12 WHEREAS, Johnson Controls Inc. strongly believes in using 13 local labor and local subcontractors to do their work and is currently in 14 the process of mentoring three (3) local companies to do their 15 installations of controls, lighting, fire alarm, and technology contracting; 16 and 17 WHEREAS, these local laborers will be trained to sell, price, 18 install, program, and commission smaller installations with the 19 oversight and assistance of Johnson Controls Inc.; and 20 WHEREAS, Johnson Controls Inc. has committed to bringing 21 additional work and jobs to Guam by using their model of leveraging 22

the electrical savings of performance based contracts to perform

upgrades to buildings, equipment, systems, etc. that create comfortable and sustainable environments; and

WHEREAS, Johnson Controls has opted to use local companies as agents of Johnson Controls, to include J2C, their York Equipment Agent, and Secure Safe Solutions, their Fire and Security Agent, both of which are staffed with local people, keeping the intellectual knowledge and earnings on Guam; and

WHEREAS, Johnson Controls' model is to share their vision and ideas, work for Guam as a trusted advisor and take pride in knowing that the implementation of the various Energy Savings Projects,

Renewable Energy Projects, Fuel Switching, etc. will benefit everyone, including the Johnson Controls' families and friends who will call

Guam 'Home'; and

WHEREAS, Johnson Controls Inc. has signed an Energy Savings

Performance Contract (ESPC) with the U.S. Navy to complete an

efficiency and conservation project at the Naval Base in Guam, which is

projected to reduce the base's energy costs by one point seven million
(1.7) dollars a year; and

WHEREAS, this project includes installing a large-scale solar photovoltaic power system, improving HVAC controls which includes retrofitting eight seven (87) air handlers, upgrading more than nine thousand (9,000) lighting fixtures for energy efficiency, and installing the company's Web services-based management platform, for forty nine (49) of the buildings at the base; and

WHEREAS, this work is part of a larger Navy initiative to make its facilities, ships and operations more energy, water, and fuel efficient; and;

WHEREAS, this project could not have come at a more opportune time for the Naval Base, as the population in Guam will increase dramatically during the next few years with the influx of thousands of military personnel and their respective families; now, therefore, be it
