RELATIVE TO COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING
RONALD A. CHARGUALAF ON THE OCCASION OF HIS
RETIREMENT FROM THE UNITED STATES NAVY WITH
THE GRADE OF MACHINIST MATE FIRST CLASS (E-6),
AND TO EXPRESSING A MOST SINCERE *UN DANGKOLO*
NA SI YU'OS MA'ASE TO HIM FOR HIS TWENTY (20)
YEARS OF SERVICE TO OUR COUNTRY AND OUR
ISLAND.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I*
2 *MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN*:

3 WHEREAS, Machinist Mate First Class Ronald A. Chargualaf began
4 his first enlistment in the United States Armed Forces in March of 1991.
5 Twenty (20) years later, and a career's worth of knowledge, insight, hard
6 work, perseverance, patience and humility, Ronald A. Chargualaf stands at
7 the forefront of a retirement that signifies the end of one journey of his life,
8 but the beginning of many others; and

9 WHEREAS, under Machinist Mate First Class Chargualaf's
10 leadership and guidance, his first supervisory role, which coincidentally
11 was bestowed upon him on *I Islan Guahan* in the year 2000, on the USS
12 Frank Cable, Chargualaf and his ten (10) man team identified and corrected
13 over eighty-four (84) galley and laundry equipment deficiencies which
14 directly contributed to the improved quality of life for all crew members;

1 **WHEREAS**, while exemplifying every aspect of the United States
2 Navy's core values of Honor, Courage, and Commitment, Machinist Mate
3 First Class Chargualaf directly and positively affected and influenced the
4 lives of over six-thousand (6,000) seamen and their families by either
5 implementing strategies to improve living conditions, preparing them for
6 enlistment in the United States Armed Forces, or providing upgrade
7 training so that they may advance in their military careers; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Machinist Mate First Class Chargualaf's commitment,
9 untiring efforts, and ceaseless dedication to the United States Armed Forces
10 has not gone unnoticed by unit commanders in the form of the Navy and
11 Marine Corps Commendation Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps
12 Achievement Medal, the Navy Good Conduct Medal, the Global War on
13 Terrorism Medal, Letters of Commendation from the Naval Service
14 Training Command, and Letters of Commendation from the Commander
15 of the Submarine Group 2; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Machinist Mate First Class Chargualaf's efforts and
17 works are felt throughout the entire United States Armed Forces while
18 simultaneously representing the Guamanian peoples and the same hard
19 work and dedication that our island culture emanates throughout its
20 people; now, therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules, on behalf of *I Mina'trentai*
22 *Unu Na Liheslaturan Guahan* and the people of Guam, does hereby
23 recognize and commend Ronald A. Chargualaf for his service in the United
24 States Navy around the world, most especially in Guam; and be it further

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Committee on
26 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attests to the adoption hereof,

1 and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Ronald A.
2 Chargualaf; and to *I Maga'Lahen Guðhan*.
