- WHEREAS, further, the College offers over 50 courses of study which are job related and prepares students for transfer to four-year colleges and universities with advanced standing in professional and technical degree programs; and
- WHEREAS, the College offers a variety of community service and special programs to prepare students for college experiences including English-as-a-Second Language, Adult Basic Education, General Education Development (GED) preparation and testing, an Adult High School Diploma program, External Diploma Program and Apprenticeship; and
- WHEREAS, in the past two years, with the advent of the anticipated military buildup on Guam, the College has seen a 26 percent increase in its postsecondary enrollment which signals an effort by many people to garner the education and training they will need to be competitive in Guam's growing workforce; and
- WHEREAS, the College's 10 Career and Technical Education programs that are taught in all five Guam public high schools have consistently served over 2000 students since 2008; and
- WHEREAS, the College has apprenticeship agreements with over 70 companies on the island, and is currently providing training to the employees of those companies, in order to increase their productivity and their earning power; and

WHEREAS, many of the effective members of this community have been 1 part of Guam Community College and have contributed to society through practice 2 of their different trades; and
