

RELATIVE TO COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING  
LOURDES A. (LOU) LEON GUERRERO ON THE OCCASION OF  
BEING NAMED THE 2010 "EXECUTIVE OF THE YEAR," AND TO  
EXPRESSING A MOST SINCERE UN DANGKOLO NA SI YU'OS  
MA'ASE' FOR HER CONTINUED SERVICE TO OUR ISLAND  
AND PEOPLE.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I  
2 MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

3 WHEREAS, following her graduation from the Academy of Our Lady of  
4 Guam, Lourdes A. (Lou) Leon Guerrero continued her education, earning her  
5 Bachelor of Science in Nursing at California State University, and a Masters of  
6 Public Health at the University of California, Los Angeles, prior to beginning her  
7 first career as a health care professional; and

8 WHEREAS, Lou Leon Guerrero's service to our island and people began  
9 in 1980 when she held the position of Staff Development Coordinator at the  
10 Guam Memorial Hospital, going on to spend the next fourteen (14) years  
11 providing healthcare services to the community through various positions both  
12 at GMH and at FHP; and

13 WHEREAS, in 1994, Lou Leon Guerrero made the conscientious decision  
14 to do more for the people of Guam and successfully sought a seat in the 27th  
15 Guam Legislature, going on to serve a total of five (5) terms as a Guam Senator,  
16 holding various distinguished positions including Majority Leader; Chairperson

1 of the Committee on Rules; Chairperson of the Committee on Health, Welfare,  
2 and Senior Citizens; Assistant Majority Leader; and member of the Committees  
3 on Health & Human Services, Natural Resources, Utilities & Micronesian Affairs,  
4 and General & Omnibus Matters; and

5 **WHEREAS**, always wanting to do more, Lou Leon Guerrero served as a  
6 board member for the Bank of Guam from 1991 to 1998 and again from 2001 until  
7 2004 when she was named Vice-Chairperson of the board, a position she held  
8 until named as Chairperson in 2006, the position she currently holds in addition  
9 her role as the President & Chief Executive Officer for the Bank of Guam; and

10 **WHEREAS**, her thirst for knowledge and education unquenched, Lou  
11 Leon Guerrero returned to school in 2009, graduating with a diploma from the  
12 Pacific Coast Banking School in Seattle, Washington; and

13 **WHEREAS**, no matter how many hats Lou Leon Guerrero has worn, her  
14 will to serve remains unhindered, remaining very engaged and involved with  
15 our island community as a board member for the Guam Telephone Authority,  
16 Guam Memorial Hospital, Ayuda Foundation, GuamPedia, and the Guam  
17 Chamber of Commerce, and also as Chair for the Pacific Youth Center, Vice-  
18 Chair for the Guam Humanities Council, and a member of the PEACE Council;  
19 and

20 **WHEREAS**, Lou Leon Guerrero has also held numerous officer and  
21 membership positions in the Guam Humanities Council, Mercy Action of the  
22 Marianas, Guam Nurses Association, American Cancer Society, Guam Heart  
23 Association, Guam Health Coordinating Council and the Medical Quality  
24 Review Co. - District II; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Lou Leon Guerrero's numerous contributions to the  
26 community have not gone unnoticed, as she holds a spot on the Academy of Our  
27 Lady of Guam's Hall of Fame, and more recently, was named the Guam Business

1 Magazine's "Executive of the Year" for the island of Guahan for 2010, the Guam  
2 Business Executive of the Year being an individual noted for: "Success and  
3 reputation in the business community, personal business creativity and  
4 entrepreneurship, leadership ability, business expansion, and community  
5 involvement;" and

6 **WHEREAS**, Her countless activities and years of service, as well as being a  
7 member of the board for Guam Memorial Hospital as the hospital received its  
8 first accreditation in almost thirty (30) years rightfully bestows such high praise  
9 on the woman who has made seeking a better way of life for the entire island of  
10 Guam and its people, her life's mission; now, therefore, be it

11 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules, on behalf of I Mina'trentai Unu  
12 Na Liheslaturan Guahan and the people of Guam, does hereby commend and  
13 congratulate Lourdes (Lou) Leon Guerrero on the occasion of her being named  
14 the 2010 "Executive of the Year"; and does hereby express a most sincere Un  
15 Dangkolo na Si Yu'os ma'ase' to her for her continued service to our island; and  
16 be it further
