WHEREAS, following her graduation from the Academy of Our Lady of Guam, Lourdes A. (Lou) Leon Guerrero continued her education, earning her Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing at California State University, and a Masters Degree in Public Health at the University of California, Los Angeles, prior to beginning her first career as a health care professional; and

8 WHEREAS, Lou Leon Guerrero's service to our island and people began in 9 1980, when she held the position of Staff Development Coordinator at the Guam 10 Memorial Hospital (GMH), going on to spend the next fourteen (14) years providing 11 healthcare services to the community through various positions, both at GMH and at 12 FHP; and

1 WHEREAS, in 1994, Lou Leon Guerrero made the conscientious decision to do more for the people of Guam and she successfully sought a seat in the 23rd Guam 2 Legislature, going on to serve a total of five (5) terms as a Guam Senator, holding 3 4 various distinguished positions, including Majority Leader; Chairperson of the 5 Committee on Rules; Chairperson of the Committee on Health, Welfare, and Senior 6 Citizens; Assistant Majority Leader; and she was a Member of the Committees on 7 Health & Human Services, Natural Resources, Utilities & Micronesian Affairs, and 8 General & Omnibus Matters; and

9 WHEREAS, always wanting to do more, Lou Leon Guerrero served as a Board 10 Member for the Bank of Guam from 1991 to 1998, and again from 2001 to 2004, 11 when she was named as Vice-Chairperson of the Board, a position she held until 12 named as Chairperson in 2006, the position she currently holds, in addition to her role 13 as the President and Chief Executive Officer for the Bank of Guam; and

WHEREAS, her thirst for knowledge and education unquenched, Lou Leon
Guerrero returned to school in 2009, graduating with a diploma from the Pacific Coast
Banking School in Seattle, Washington; and

WHEREAS, no matter how many hats Lou Leon Guerrero has worn, her will to serve remains unhindered, as she continues to be very engaged and involved with our island community, serving as a Board Member for the Guam Telephone Authority; the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority; the *Ayuda* Foundation; the GuamPedia; and the Guam Chamber of Commerce; and also as the Chairperson for the Pacific Youth Center; as the Vice-Chairperson for the Guam Humanities Council; and as a member of the PEACE Council; and

WHEREAS, Lou Leon Guerrero has also held numerous officer and membership positions in the Guam Humanities Council; Mercy Action of the Marianas; the Guam Nurses Association; the American Cancer Society; the Guam Heart Association; the Guam Health Coordinating Council; and the Medical Quality
 Review Co. - District II; and

WHEREAS, Lou Leon Guerrero's numerous contributions to the community have not gone unnoticed, as she was selected to be in the Academy of Our Lady of Guam's Hall of Fame, and more recently, she was named as the Guam Business Magazine's 2010 "Executive of the Year"; the Guam Business Executive of the Year being an individual noted for: "Success and reputation in the business community, personal business creativity and entrepreneurship, leadership ability, business expansion, and community involvement;" and

WHEREAS, in recognition of Lou Leon Guerrero's achievements, countless contributions and years of service, including as a Member on the Board of Trustees of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority as the Hospital received its first accreditation in almost thirty (30) years, high praise and honor are rightfully bestowed on the woman who has made seeking a better way of life for the entire island of Guam and its people, her life's mission; now, therefore, be it
