WHEREAS, Senior Airman Ibanez was assigned to the Information Technology Directorate, National Cryptologic Representative Afghanistan, while supporting the U.S. Ambassador and international security assistance forces in the Afghani theater of operations; and

WHEREAS, during his deployment, Senior Airman Ibanez frequently worked under the grueling weather conditions prevalent in Afghanistan in order to ensure the continuity of IT operations, volunteering numerous times, often outside of his job specialty, to work at forward operating bases, while maintaining and transforming network access points at more than twenty facilities incountry; and

WHEREAS, Airman Ibanez also programmed and performed maintenance on more than 300 unique network communications systems, supporting data integration for joint and coalition operations, and was one of only five dedicated IT experts in the entire theater of operations during his deployment; and

WHEREAS, Senior Airman Ibanez's commitment to the United States Air Force's core values of "Integrity First, Service Before Self, and Excellence in All We Do," enabled him to become one of a very short list of junior members to have received the Defense Meritorious Service Medal at such an early stage of his military career; and,

**WHEREAS**, such acknowledgement of the accomplishments and achievements of a young son of Guam deserve appropriate recognition and honor from *I Liheslatura*, now, therefore, be it
