- 6 WHEREAS, Dr. Reinman endeavored to complete the first survey
- 7 the ancient sites of the entirety of Guam in , identifying and cataloguing of
- 8 138 latte sites over our entire Island, totaling approximately 250 individual

- latte homes and the archeological artifacts that surrounded those villages,
 including burial grounds of our ancestors; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Reinman worked in partnership with many
 Chamorro people on this extensive study, as well as the Micronesian Area
 Research Center, to process artifacts and materials recovered in the
 excavations, empowering local people and institutions in these important
 processes; and
- WHEREAS, the historically important site of Pagat was excavated initially by Dr. Reinman in 1974; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Reinman has written numerous books and articles
 on the archeological resources of our island, and thus made this important
 information available to our People and to those who are interested in our
 history; and
- WHEREAS, the Micronesian Area Research Center (MARC) has
 chosen to officially and publicly recognize his contributions to our
 community at the 3rd Annual MARC and Charter Day Event; now,
