BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, on March 27, 1981, Jane Leon Guerrero Taitague joined the University of Guam (UOG) community as a member of the professional administrative staff; and

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2011, Ms Taitague will officially retire from her current position as an Administrative Assistant with the School of Business and Public Administration after serving the University family spanning a total of thirty (30) years; and

WHEREAS, Jane has been part of the University Community for most of her professional life, and has demonstrated a true and continuing commitment towards the mission of the University, rendering quality services to the faculty, students and general public who have depended on her assistance; and

WHEREAS, Jane has exemplified the meaning of "quality customer service," never turning anyone away and always representing the best interests of the University in everything she does; Jane requires little direction in meeting the

1 responsibilities attached to her position and has been instrumental in developing
2 new systems to facilitate the work of her office, including automation initiatives;

4 **WHEREAS**, Jane has made good use of electronic communication to
5 facilitate efficiency within the SBPA program units while at the same time being
6 able to communicate with all members of the SBPA; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Jane's positive and efficient attitude starts bright and early
8 around the seven o'clock hour, with her beautiful smile as she attacks the array of
9 daily tasks of the SBPA Dean's Office with ease, confidence and promptness; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Ms Taitague served everyone with courtesy and more
11 importantly, genuinely extended assistance above and beyond expectations to all
12 who came to her – whether, visitor, student, faculty, staff, etc. - no one was turned
13 anyone away and she met requests in a timely and respectful manner; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Jane Taitague has earned a reputation as the “go-to gal”
15 whenever something needed to get done or done correctly; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Jane exemplified professionalism, as an employee with the
17 School of Business and Public Administration, Jane was also well organized, her
18 work station was always neat and organized with “Outstanding Job Performance
19 Evaluations” consistently received from 1990 through 2010; and

20 **WHEREAS**, she has repeatedly been nominated “Employee of the
21 Year/Quarter,” in the course of her thirty-two (32) years of service at the
22 University of Guam: Jane was Nominated for Employee of the Quarter for three
23 (3) years (1991, 1992, 1994) and Nominated for Employee of the Year (Category I
24 & II), eight (8) times, from 1998 to 2010: (2010, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, 2002,
25 1999, 1998); and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 2005 she was the “Employee of the Year” for the Secretarial
2 and Clerical Personnel Category; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Jane regularly and actively engaged in extra-curricular
4 activities, she has served on various committees, she served as a member of the
5 Christmas Party Committees, the Labor Day Picnic Committees, and the Charter
6 Day Committees; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Taitague has been recognized for the following: 2003 -
8 Super “I can do anything Award”, (2003) Super Pongsona Trooper Award” from
9 SBPA Dean, 2002- assisting during the Governor Great Debates, 2004
10 Administering the November 2004 Certified Internal Auditor Examination, 1997
11 Satellite Registration contribution, 1991 Triton Women’s Basketball Team
12 Appreciation, Assisted during the 5th/6th/7th/8th/9th/10th/11th/12th - Island
13 Conferences on Public Administration, and in 1989 received an “Excellence in
14 Service” award; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Jane is a source of morale and inspiration for her fellow co-
16 workers, she is the “volunteer interior decorator,” often using personal funds or
17 decorations she’s collected though the years to make sure the School of Business
18 and Public Administration Dean’s Office is presentable and exudes character, as
19 well, she takes the lead during different holidays or special occasion celebrations,
20 always ensuring cheers and smiles will be received; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the SBPA and the university community will miss Jane’s
22 presence and, as described by the Dean of SBPA, her work ethic - “dedication to
23 excellent service” - while employed with the University of Guam, School of
24 Business and Public Administration; now therefore, be it
