WHEREAS, Josephine Mesa, affectionately known as 'Jo', is one such
 member, as well as the Association's Vice President. She has recently been
 awarded the prestigious tile 'Volunteer of the Year' for her outstanding committed
 service to GMHVA; and

WHEREAS, Jo is extremely deserving of this award, as it was her vision, initiative, and tireless commitment that played a huge role in certain unprecedented GMHVA activities; and

WHEREAS, it was Jo's independent research that led to the Association's adoption of the President's Volunteer Service Awards Program. Consequently, as a result of these efforts, members who had accumulated at least one hundred (100) hours of annual service received recognition endorsed by the President of the United States; and

WHEREAS, through her own initiative, Jo also prepared the nomination of GMHVA's 2010 Volunteer Week events and activities for submission to the National Volunteer's Week competition; and

WHEREAS, as a result, GMHVA won 3rd place nationwide and received national recognition in the Positive Promotions February 2011 issue and a monetary prize of one hundred (100) dollars; and

WHEREAS, Jo also initiated a Volunteer's Conference in conjunction with the recognition and awards day as a means of generating ideas from the

membership to assist in the strategic planning. Through the work of the

whereas, Jo has undoubtedly increased GMHVA's community image and visibility as she coordinated with Connor Murphy on the write-up and submission of GMHVA's nomination to the American Hospital Association's "Hospital Awards for Volunteer Excellence" (HAVE), assumed the responsibility of preparing the Association's 'Big V" newsletter, participated in the Serve Guam program, and networked with the other agencies in enlisting support for the Association's fundraising efforts; and

WHEREAS, On top of her executive duties as the Vice President, Jo has additionally taken the lead on major fundraising efforts, to include chairing the
