**BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNO NA LIHESLATURAN  
GUÅHAN:**

- 1       **WHEREAS**, on October 01, 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed into
- 2   law legislation that designated May 15 annually as a special day to honor
- 3   peace officers for their commitment and service in the protection of citizens in
- 4   many communities nationwide from criminal activities, especially extreme
- 5   violence and terrorism; and

1       **WHEREAS**, on this special day set aside to honor peace officers, Guam  
2 joins communities throughout the nation in paying honor and recognition to  
3 the courageous men and women who dedicate their lives to enforcing the  
4 laws, protecting citizens from injustice, and providing public safety services  
5 for all Guam residents; and

6       **WHEREAS**, peace officers throughout the island are asked daily to  
7 place themselves within danger in protecting the community and in providing  
8 public safety, and at times this may require that they risk their lives and pay  
9 the ultimate price; a tremendous cost to the community, but a valuable service  
10 to the protection of our island and our people; and

11       **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam will observe “Peace Officers’ Memorial  
12 Day” on May 16, 2011, a time to acknowledge the men and women in uniform  
13 who have paid the ultimate sacrifice while serving in the line of duty, and  
14 have given of their lives in the protection of life and property for the people of  
15 Guam; and

16       **WHEREAS**, the following individuals have served as peace officers for  
17 the people of Guam, and have given of their lives: Police Sergeant, Frankie E.

5 Police Officer I, Manuel A. Aquino; Police Lieutenant Francisco C. Toves;  
6 Police Officer I, Eddie A. Santos; Conservation Officer, Francisco M. Isezaki;  
7 Drug Enforcement Administration Special Agent Larry D. Wallace;  
8 Department of Corrections Officer, Douglas W. Mashburn; United States Air  
9 Force Airman Laurie Lucas; and United States Air Force Sergeant Stacey E.  
10 Levay; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the family members, to include spouses, children, and  
12 parents, should be recognized and appreciated for the tremendous support  
13 provided to their love one in their individual service to the law enforcement  
14 community and to the island of Guam; now, therefore, be it

15 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Uno na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
16 on behalf of the people of Guam, extend special tribute and a Dangkolo' Na Si  
17 Yu'os Ma'ase' to the honorable men and women who proudly served the

1 people of Guam, and gave the ultimate sacrifice of their lives in the line of  
2 duty; and hereby encourages the people of Guam to join in the observance of  
3 “Peace Officers’ Memorial Day”, May 16, 2011; and be it further

4 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Trentai Uno na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
5 further extend acknowledgement and appreciation to the family members, to  
6 include spouses, children, and parents, of the peace officers who have given  
7 their lives in service to the island community; and be it further

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Secretary of the  
9 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be  
10 thereafter transmitted to a family member of Guam’s fallen heroes; Chief of  
11 Police, Guam Police Department; Director, Department of Corrections;  
12 Director, Department of Agriculture; Drug Enforcement Administration,  
13 Guam; United States Air Force, Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J. B.  
14 Calvo, *I Maga’lahen Guåhan*.
