
## I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2011(FIRST) Regular Session

Resolution No. 91-31(co2)

RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING MRS. **PRECIOSA REYES** ULLOA ON HER ONE HUNDRED (100)**YEARS OF** LIFE, ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE ISLAND OF GUAM AND FOR BEING A CITIZENS' 2011 **SENIOR MONTH** CENTENARIAN.



## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI UNU LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

- WHEREAS, Preciosa Reyes Ulloa was born to Maria delosReyes and
- 2 Vicente Ulloa, in the village of Talofofo on October 24, 1910; and
- WHEREAS, she being the eldest of six (6) children had many
- 4 responsibilities growing up and naturally fell into the role as a caregiver, as
- 5 well as being seen as a mother figure because she worked tirelessly to ensure
- 6 that everyone in her family was fine by attending to their individual needs;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Preciosa married Felix Taitague and they had two (2)
- 9 children together, Josefa (†) and David; and

WHEREAS, after the passing of her first husband at an early age,
Preciosa married Mr. Vicente Castro in 1945 and together they had five (5)
children. Their five (5) children are Joseph, Frank(†), Pedro (†), Arthur and
Maria; and

WHEREAS, as a mother, she loved and provided for the physical and emotional needs of her children. Even as her children became adults, Preciosa always felt obliged to continue loving and caring for them.; and

WHEREAS, despite Preciosa's 2nd marriage ending in a divorce sometime in 1977, she was there to care for him on the weekends when he was gravely ill with cancer, which demonstrated her caring and forgiving nature; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Ulloa worked as a Housekeeper for the late Governor Carlos G. Camacho, then later his brother Luis Camacho in Windward Hills; and

WHEREAS, Preciosa is described as very neat and organized as evidenced by her choice of work and was not one to complain. She took it upon herself to ensure that things were done properly. She worked hard and took pride in the quality of work that she produced; and

WHEREAS, in 1994, while at work, she experienced a stroke where she fell down hitting her head in the process. She was quickly transported by the Guam Fire Department via ambulance to the emergency room. As a

- 31 result of the stroke, Preciosa's independence was affected in the process;

- 33 WHEREAS, At that time, her medical doctor predicted that she
- possibly had six (6) months to live. Given the nature of Preciosa's health,
- 35 the family felt that it was in the best interest of Preciosa to receive the
- 36 required care at Saint Dominic's Senior Care Home. To date, after almost
- 37 17 years later, Preciosa has lived over the life expectancy that her doctor
- predicted and her family is looking forward in celebrating her 101<sup>st</sup> birthday
- 39 on October 24, 2011; and
- 40 WHEREAS, Preciosa's longevity was attributed to taking care of
- 41 herself and daily walks to church for prayers before the 7:00am mass in
- 42 Talofofo; and
- WHEREAS, Preciosa's devotion to her faith and dedication to her
- family is evident today, as she is blessed with 27 grandchildren, 40 great
- 45 grandchildren, 18 great-great grandchildren, and 2 great-great
- 46 grandchildren; and
- 47 **WHEREAS,** People who have known Preciosa would describe her as
- a very simple, patient, graceful, devoted, and quiet woman who dedicated
- 49 her life to her faith, family and work ; and now therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan, does
- 51 hereby, on behalf of the People of Guam, recognize and honor Ms. Preciosa

Reyes Ulloa on one hundred (100) years of life dedicated to her faith and 52 family; and be it further 53 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the 54 Chairman of the Committee on Rules certify, and the Secretary of the 55 Legislature attest to, and the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same 56 be thereafter transmitted to Ms. Preciosa Reyes Ulloa; and to the Honorable 57 Edward J.
