- WHEREAS, Melchor David Ponce was born on January 6, 1910 in

- 4 WHEREAS, In 1940, he married Felisa Galang and together they
- 5 raised eight (8) children who are Orlando "Roland", Leonardo (†), Cora,
- 6 Lina, Cely (†), Fred, Benito "Bong" and Zaldy in the province of Sapang
- 7 Bato, Pampanga; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Melchor worked as a laborer at Clark Air Force Base
- 9 and was a farmer for many years. He grew crops of sugar cane, sweet
- 10 potato, corn, tomatoes, and taro on their land; and

- WHEREAS, He was petitioned by his son and arrived on Guam in 12 1974; and
- WHEREAS, He did landscaping for a few private homes, before working as a gardener at Agana Shopping Center formerly Town House, for
- 15 Mr. Ken Jones. After years of doing what he loved to do, he retired; and
- WHEREAS, In 1991, 11 years after the passing of his wife, Felisa,
 Melchor married Ligaya Muldong in Pampanga, Philippines. In that same
 year, they were forced to evacuate when Mount Pinatubo erupted. Many
 homes in their province were destroyed and damaged, buried beneath
 volcanic ashes and lava. He returned to Guam with his new wife, living a
- WHEREAS, Melchor is blessed with 17 Grandchildren and 23 Greatgrandchildren. His children, grandchildren, and numerous great-grand children reside in Guam, Washington, Hawaii, Canada, and the Philippines; and

simple life together in Harmon; and

- WHEREAS, Melchor enjoyed gardening, even while he required the use of a wheelchair. He also enjoyed watching Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN), an American cable television network, which presents Catholic themed programming; and
- WHEREAS, Melchor read the Bible and prayed daily to God. He believed in the power of prayer. Melchor prayed not only for himself but
