- WHEREAS, Maria Fejeran Naputi was born to Maria Fejeran and 1
- Vicente Paulino Naputi, in the village of Inarajan on May 9, 1910; and 2
- WHEREAS, She married Pedro Meno Mantanona on February 26, 3
- 1926 and together, they raised 12 children, seven (7) sons and five (5) 4
- daughters. The Mantanona's were married for 61 years; and 5
- WHEREAS, "Ama", as she is fondly called by family members and 6
- all who know her is the eldest of 12 siblings. She has one surviving sister, 7
- Antonia Naputi Reyes, who is 87 years old and resides in the village of 8
- Talofofo; and 9

10 WHEREAS, Being the 'eldest, a lot of responsibilities were placed on 11 Tan Ama, which included having to look after her siblings, upkeep of the family home, laundry, sewing and preparing meals. She learned to cook and 12 13 sew from her grandmother, her teacher and mentor, and the memories of her grandmother impacted her relationship with her family, devoting her entire 14 life to caring for her family; and 15 WHEREAS, "Tan Ama" loved to cook, sew, and garden. She did all 16 her cooking the traditional way, cooking over burning wood. She is well-17 known for her delicious Chamorro Cake; and 18 WHEREAS, her favorite food dish is fish cooked in any manner, as 19 she is not too keen with red meat. Amongst her other favorite dishes, 20 21 includes atuli (soup made of corn), gollai åpan lemmai (bread fruit cooked in coconut milk), taro, bananas, and eating a lot of vegetables; and 22 23

WHEREAS, as a seamstress, Tan Ama had no need to buy clothing for her family, sewing all their clothes; and

WHEREAS, although her mobility is very limited today, she loves being outdoors. In her stronger days, she loved gardening vegetables and flowers. Her favorite flower is the pink *Flores Rosa*;

WHEREAS, Tan Ama is a member of the Inarajan Christian Mothers organization. As a devoted Catholic, praying the novena every three months

33	being a devoted wife, a loving and caring mother, and a God-fearing

36	family is evident today, as she is blessed with 61 grandchildren, 183 great
37	grandchildren, 116 great-great grandchildren, and one (1) great-great-great

40	101th birthday on May 9th, 2011; and now therefore, be it
