- 8 the needs of parents and the broader community by supporting an improved quality of life,

- 2 life of their island community; and
- WHEREAS, since its foundation in 1992, the Guam Child Care and Development
- 4 Association (GCCDA) has championed the improvement of the lives of children and
- 5 families on Guam through its focus on child development and the acknowledgement of
- 6 parents, teachers, stakeholders and care providers, who ensure the wholesome growth and
