Relative to recognizing and commending Annalakshmi Wignarajah for her significant contributions to the island of Guam, and for enriching Guam's demographic, cultural melting pot.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* MINA 'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Annalakshmi Wignarajah, affectionately known as 'Anna', 1 was born on March 4, 1939 in Sri Lanka; and 2 3 WHEREAS, Annalakshmi Wignarajah moved to Guam in March of 1973 with her two young sons Muresh and Dushyantan, and her loving husband 4 Thyagarajah, also known as 'Wigna' who was sent to Guam to set up an Otis 5 Elevator Company office, a business he successfully ran for more than twenty five 6 years; and 7 WHEREAS, Anna has always had a strong love of children and volunteered 8 her time with a group of special children at the Speech and Hearing Center at 9 10 Public Health where she was able to utilize some Montessori learning materials.

11	This sparked great interest and passion as she had been trained by Dr. Maria
12	Montessori herself, having acquired training and an 'Association Montessori
13	Internationale Diploma' in 1971 for 3-6 year old children; and
14	WHEREAS, Anna dreamt of one day opening a Montessori program on the
15	island; and
16	WHEREAS, this dream was materialized in 1976, as the Montessori School
17	of Guam first opened its doors at this time, in the living room of the Wignarajah
18	home in Tamuning; and
19	WHEREAS, this school was successfully operated by Anna for over thirty
20	five years in Guam. Their entire educational program was set up around nurturing
21	the development of the total child, and encouraged children to be problem solvers
22	and critical thinkers; and
23	WHEREAS, in addition to her committed service to children's education,
24	Anna, upon her arrival to the island, also saw a golden opportunity to meet and
25	interact with people from other ethnic backgrounds, which made her interested in
26	joining the International Women's Club of Guam, an organization she has been a
27	part of for many years; and
28	WHEREAS, since then, Anna has been an active charter member of the
29	IWCG and assumed the title of President in 1979 and consecutively in 1980; and

30	WHEREAS, Anna voluntarily became a member of the International
31	Reading Association and has been closely involved with early childhood education
32	on the island ever since. Indeed, in 1985 and 1986, she became the President of
33	the Guam Childcare and Development Organization; and
34	WHEREAS, Anna additionally attended her first Federation of
35	Asian/Pacific Women Association (FAWA) conference which was held in Guam
36	in 1998; and
37	WHEREAS, Anna became a member of a group of FAWA representatives
38	from Guam that went to Singapore to attend yet another conference in 2005; and
39	WHEREAS, Annalakshmi Wignarajah was voted Madame International in
40	2007, a prestigious title she is very proud of; now, therefore be it
41	<b>RESOLVED</b> , that I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does
42	hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Annalakshmi
43	Wignarajah for her committed service to the betterment of the island of Guam;
44	and be it further
45	<b>RESOLVED</b> , that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest
46	to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to
47	Annalakshmi Wignarajah and to the Honorable Edward B. Calvo, I Maga'lahen
48	Guåhan.
