- 3 contributions before stepping out of the classroom in 2003 to serve as a

- 6 inspirational, casting the mold for educational achievement at Carbullido
- 7 Elementary where she was one of the pioneers of the Department of
- 8 Education Extended Day, or DEED, pilot program at the Barrigada model

- nearly every content area; serving as part of the school team responsible for
- developing the "homework planner," which continues to be used today,
- and was lauded by the U.S. DOE as being "102 percent" effective as it
- promoted communication and collaboration between teachers and families

- school coordinator, served as a master teacher for UoG student teachers
