**RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING, COMMENDING AND  
THANKING MS. MARY PANGELINAN ECLAVEA FOR  
HER DEDICATION TO THE EDUCATION OF OUR  
CHILDREN AND OUR FAMILIES FOR NEARLY FOUR (4)  
DECADES.**

1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS,** Mary Pangelinan Eclavea was born September 12, 1951  
4        to Priscilla Pangelinan Eclavea and Jose Miner Eclavea, and raised in the  
5        village of Sinajana;

6        **WHEREAS,** Mary attended Sinajana Elementary School, Saint Jude  
7        Thaddeus Junior High School and the Academy of Our Lady of Guam,  
8        where she graduated in 1969, before leaving the island in pursuit of higher  
9        education, and entering Mount Saint Mary College in California;

10       **WHEREAS,** Mary earned a bachelor's degree in psychology and  
11       upon returning to Guam, she became certified in education, and stepped  
12       into her first role as educator in 1973 teaching in the Guam Department of  
13       Education (DOE) classrooms at Adelup Elementary, Wettengel Elementary,

1 Maria Ulloa Elementary, Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary and finally, at  
2 Baltazar P. Carbullido Elementary – where she continually made valuable  
3 contributions – before stepping out of the classroom in 2003 to serve as a  
4 Direct Instruction coordinator;

5       **WHEREAS**, throughout her career Mary has been tireless and  
6 inspirational, casting the mold for educational achievement at Carbullido  
7 Elementary where she was one of the pioneers of the Department of  
8 Education Extended Day, or DEED, pilot program at the Barrigada model  
9 school; implementing the multi-age program; serving as chairwoman for  
10 nearly every content area; serving as part of the school team responsible for  
11 developing the “homework planner,” which continues to be used today,  
12 and was lauded by the U.S. DOE as being “102 percent” effective as it  
13 promoted communication and collaboration between teachers and families  
14 leading to student success; participated in the development of the DOE  
15 student performance standards and indicators, served as the summer  
16 school coordinator, served as a master teacher for UoG student teachers  
17 and, setting the foundation of the Direct Instruction program when  
18 Carbullido Elementary was one of five pilot schools;

19       **WHEREAS**, Mary is a proud mother and mother-in-law of Michael  
20 and Lisa Lujan Eclavea, Morris and Eva Eclavea Aguon, Jerrad & Josette  
21 Eclavea Cruz, Mariam Eclavea and Jose Eclavea; and, proud grandmother  
22 of Rebecca, Sabrina, Olivia, Nathan, Joseph, Isaiah, Seth and Elan; now,  
23 therefore, be it

1           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules, on behalf of *I Mina'trentai*  
2   *Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam does hereby,  
3   recognize, commend and thank Ms. Mary Pangelinan Eclavea for her  
4   dedication to the education of our children and our families for nearly four  
5   (4) decades; and be it further
